Roy Sinor typically presents the basic NCRS Judging Process in a conference room, We usually have about 100 participants. Duration is 1 hour and it's worth 1 judging point. Seating is first come first serve, sign-in is during meeting and no advanced sign-up is required. Conference room is up the stairs at the Old Town Hall near the judging field. Observer Judges (OJ's) are encouraged to attend; all other judging levels are welcome.

ADVANCED JUDGING SEMINAR-

Friday, 9:30 to 11:30 a.m. and 1:00 to 3:30 p.m.

Repeated on Saturday at same times



Alan Foster coordinates Master Judges in an outdoor session to cover Flight Judging techniques. NCRS example Corvettes from each generation are used along with a lift. Sign-up in advance is requested on sheets near the Judges Tent in the Show Field. Seminar meets each morning in the judging field at the lift. Class size is limited to 50 people per day. Attendance at both the morning and afternoon session is required to earn 3 judging points. Participation in both days is not required and will not earn extra points. The Seminar is aimed at the experienced judge and Master Judges are encouraged to participate in the discussions. This Seminar is not oriented for Observer Judges (OJ's).
